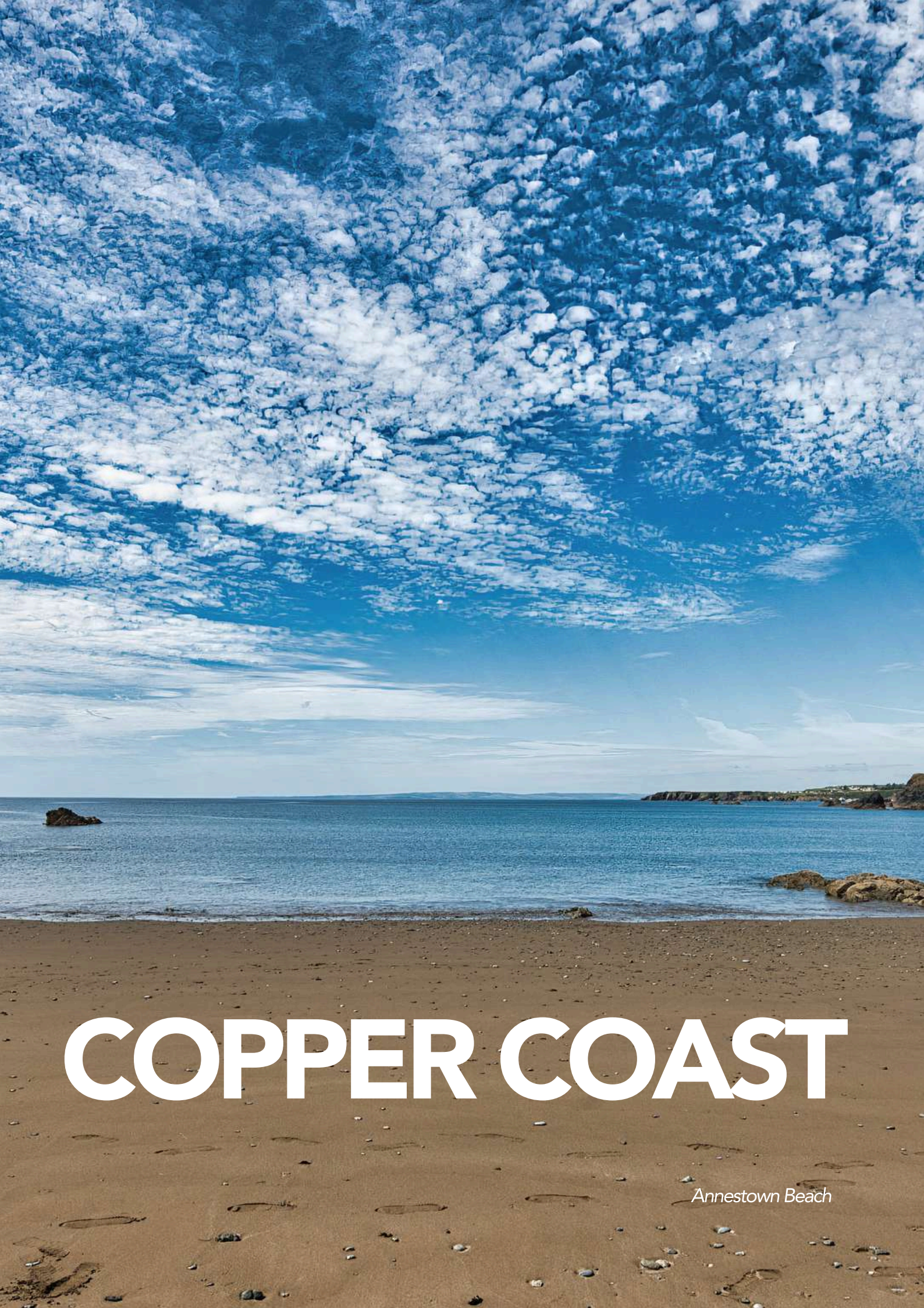

The Copper Coast UNESCO Global Geopark and Visitor Centre is nestled along Ireland's southeast coastline, between Tramore and Dungarvan in County Waterford. Stretching from Fenor in the east to Stradbally in the west and reaching as far north as Dunhill, this remarkable landscape was designated a European Geopark in 2001 before earning UNESCO Global Geopark status in 2015.

Named after the 19th-century copper mines at its core, the Copper Coast spans approximately 25 kilometres of breath-taking shoreline. Its rugged beauty is defined by scalloped beaches, hidden coves, and dramatic rocky headlands. Shaped by ancient oceans, volcanic activity, deserts, and ice sheets, the region's unique geological history forms the foundation of both its striking natural scenery and rich cultural heritage.

The Comeragh area, located in County Waterford, Ireland, is a region of natural beauty and historical significance. The expansive Comeragh mountain range provides a variety of walking opportunities, catering to both serious hikers and casual Sunday strollers.

At its core, visitors will find a unique landscape— a boggy plateau scattered with small loughs. Easily accessible, the Comeraghs offer stunning views that stretch across the county and down to the sea. Often referred to as one of Ireland's best-kept secrets, the area is home to remarkable sights, including the dramatic Mahon Falls, which cascades down a cliff face. Also, the mysterious 'magic road' that runs through the gap of the range adds an intriguing element to the region's charm.

Gaeltacht na nDéise is nestled in the sunny southeast of Ireland, by the sea, offering stunning views at every turn. This small Gaeltacht is made up of two parishes, An Rinn and An Sean Phobal, with a population of just over 2,000 people. The community's deep love for the Irish language, traditional music, and singing adds a unique vibrancy to the area.

Gaeltacht na nDéise is known for its distinctive Irish language dialect and is renowned for its traditional music and Sean Nós (traditional) singing. In recent years, the number of Irish speakers in the area has grown, with over 500 people across An Rinn and An Sean Phobal now speaking Irish daily. Comhlucht Forbartha na nDéise has played a key role, through the Irish Language Plan, in supporting local groups, committees, clubs, and schools by providing the community with regular and diverse opportunities to use Irish in daily life. So, make sure to use whatever Irish you have when you visit the area!
